Indeed, they rejoice in our confusion and wasted efforts when we do not use this time and energy to work for Khilafah (Caliphate) and the true power that will end their hegemony in the Dounia.

Our role as women is to culture the next generation of visionary Islamic leaders who are independently changing the political landscape to remove the oppression of the entire global Ummah.
