

## The Tyrant Saves the Tyrant!

### News:

On 8 December, IA tass.ru reported: *“Former Syrian President Bashar al-Assad is in Moscow and has been granted asylum in Russia, a Kremlin source told TASS. ‘Assad and his family members have arrived in Moscow. Russia, based on humanitarian considerations, has granted them asylum,’ the agency’s interlocutor said.*

*Moscow considers it necessary to resume negotiations on the settlement of the situation in Syria under the auspices of the UN. The leaders of the armed Syrian opposition have guaranteed the security of Russian military bases and diplomatic institutions on the territory of Syria.”*

### Comment:

After tyrant Bashar al-Assad failed in his task and became unnecessary for his master, the United States, he was, as they say, written off. The Muslims of Syria, like a tsunami, were in Damascus in a matter of days and tyrant Bashar fled the country. To the mad tyrant's rescue came the even more sophisticated tyrant Putin, who, like his counterpart Bashar al-Assad, is blacklisted under sanctions by the world community. Putin basically doesn't care anymore, one crime more or less, after he unleashed the war in Ukraine.
