At a press conference following the G7 Summit in the Bavarian village Krün, President Barack Obama admitted that the US does not have a complete strategy for countering the Islamic State terror group.

"When a finalized plan is presented to me by the Pentagon, then I will share it with the American people," Obama said. "We don't yet have a complete strategy because it requires commitments on the part of the Iraqis as well."

### Comment:

While IS is getting more and more control in Syria, Iraq and Libya, no one can believe that the "superpower" has no complete strategy against it. The airstrikes and the commando raid last month in Eastern Syria that killed the IS leader shows that the U.S. intelligence has all the information and ability to execute when it is needed.
