Minister of Religious Affairs and Endowments (Al-Awqaaf) Visits Hizb ut Tahrir

(Translated)

A delegation from Hizb ut Tahrir / Wilayah Sudan, led by Ustaadh Nasser Ridha (Abu Reda), head of the Central Communications Committee of Hizb ut Tahrir in Wilayah Sudan, accompanied by Ustaadh Ibrahim Othman (Abu Khalil), Official spokesman for the Hizb in Wilayah Sudan, and his assistant Ustaadh Mohammed Jami (Abu Ayman), hosted Dr. Omar Bakhit Mohammed Adam, the Federal Minister of Religious Affairs and Endowments (Al-Awqaaf), at the Hizb's office in Port Sudan on Saturday, 21 Jumada Al-Awwal 1446 AH corresponding to November 23, 2024.

In his opening remarks, Ust. Nasser warmly welcomed the minister and introduced the delegation. He then provided an overview of Hizb ut Tahrir, describing it as a political party striving to resume Islamic life through the establishment of the Khilafah Rashidah (Rightly-Guided Caliphate) on the method of Prophethood. He emphasized the obligation to work towards the Khilafah (Caliphate) and explained that the party follows the Prophet Muhammad's (swt) methodology in establishing a state, which involves forming a bloc based on Islam, engaging with society through intellectual struggle and political activism, and seeking support from those with power and influence.

Ustaadh Nasser also spoke about Western, particularly American, plans to manipulate mosques and religious institutions to serve their agendas and the disbelievers' aim to alter religious discourse.

The minister expressed appreciation for the role of Hizb ut Tahrir but noted that the current circumstances necessitate supporting the military. Ustaadh Nasser, in turn, explained the party's religious and political stance on the ongoing war.

The meeting concluded with an agreement to continue such discussions.
