A Delegation from Hizb ut Tahrir / Wilayah Sudan Visits the Head of the Democratic Unionist Party in Al-Obeid

(Translated)

A delegation from Hizb ut Tahrir / Wilayah of Sudan, led by Ustadh Al-Nazir Muhammad Hussein – Member of the Council of Hizb ut Tahrir in Wilayah of Sudan – accompanied by Ustadh Issam al-Din Abdul Qadir, visited Ustadh Khalid Hussein, Head of the Democratic Unionist Party, in his office in the city of Al-Obeid, on Tuesday 3 Rabi' al-Awwal 1447 AH corresponding to 26 August 2025 CE, as part of the campaign organized by the Hizb to foil the scheme of separating Darfur.

Ustadh Al-Nazir spoke about America's scheme to tear Sudan apart according to the map of retired American General Ralph Peters, inspired by the ideas of the Jewish American intelligence officer Bernard Lewis, the originator of the idea of the "Blood Borders" – i.e., tearing apart what is already torn on ethnic, regional, and sectarian bases – which is the same pattern that America previously pursued in the separation of the South, and is now following to separate Darfur! Among the most prominent political actions that have been carried out in this regard is the announcement of the formation of a parallel government in Nyala, the capital of South Darfur, headed by the Rapid Support Forces (RSF). Hizb ut Tahrir / Wilayah of Sudan has put in place a program to expose and foil this scheme.

Ustadh Khalid expressed his gratitude for the visit, his appreciation of the distinct programs of Hizb ut Tahrir, the refinement of its ideas, and its work to preserve the unity of the country, affirming that he supports this endeavor, and that his office is open for any work that serves this direction.
